

Lions Club of Huntington County and Kids Kampus team up for Operation Kid Sight Rescheduled for February 3rd & 4th

Due to weather on Wednesday, January 28th and Thursday, January 29th, The Lions Club of Huntington County, which includes the clubs in Andrews, Bippus, Huntington, and Roanoke and Kids Kampus, has rescheduled Operation Kids sight for Tuesday, February 3rd and Wednesday, February 4th. The Lions Club will be at Kids Kampus, 435 Campus Street, from 9:00-11:30 A.M. and 12:30 to 3:00 P.M. so children ages 18 months through age 5 can receive free eye screenings.

Just a reminder, this event is open to **any** child in Huntington and surrounding counties; you do not have to be enrolled at Kids Kampus. Any child participating will need written permission from parents to participate in the vision screening. Consent forms are available at Kids Kampus and can be completed by parents the day of the screening. No appointments will be necessary. The cost of the photo vision screening is paid in full by the Lions Club of Huntington County.

The vision screening provides instant photographs of each child's eyes to determine the presence of possible eye disorders, and is approximately 85-90% effective in detecting significant factors that can cause a decrease in vision. Photo screening is a vision screening device- it is not a diagnostic tool. It is part of a comprehensive vision care program including regular eye exams by an eye care professional.

“The goal of the project is that we want all of the two to five-year-olds in Huntington County to participate in Operation Kid Sight,” said Herb Mills, Chairman of the “Operation Kid Sight” program for the Lion’s Club of Huntington County.
